

INTERNATIONAL YOUNG GOVERNANCE PROFESSIONALS' SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION FORM 2018

The IYGP scholarship fund is designed to support young professionals interested in effective boardroom governance either in the corporate or non-profit sector. It will be administered by the International Policy Governance Association (IPGA) and is designed to encourage international participation by alleviating some of the costs associated with attending the annual IYGP summits. Attending our yearly summit is a chance for young people to learn about best governance practices from established leaders in the industry and to create individual and collective momentum through sharing their insights and ambitions.

Completion of the following application is required for all those interested in being considered as a recipient of the International Young Governance Professionals' Scholarship Fund. All applicants must be between the ages of 18-30, on or before December 31, 2018.

The International Policy Governance Association and the International Young Governance Professionals thank all applicants for their interest; however, only those who meet criteria demonstrating the greatest need will be granted a scholarship.

Applicants will be considered based on a variety of factors, including (but not limited to): financial need, distance required to travel in order to attend the summit, level of governance related interest and involvement.

Successful applicants will be notified of their award on or before April 30, 2018, and will be required to submit relevant conference travel and accommodation receipts. They will be reimbursed a minimum of \$250 USD up to a maximum of \$750 USD.
